
Freebird - Importing a species list


Note: If you find you can't open or create a workspace (because it is greyed out) then you probably need to import, or create, a species list. A species list is necessary in order to mark up a spectrogram with actual species.

Importing a species list

From the main menu, choose *Option*, then *Species List* from the drop down menu, and the following dialog box will appear:-




Select the Import button (lower left), and navigate the filesystem to find your species list (which is a .csv file)




Select the desired .csv file and click Open, and it will appear in the Species List dialog box as follows:-

So the OK button goes from greyed out, to active.

Click OK.
